The purpose of this public hearing is for consideration of:

1. Public Hearing on tentative budget and tentative millage rates:
 - a. Resolution No. 150-2003 (City Clerk reads *in full.*)

A resolution of the City of Boca Raton adopting tentative millage rates necessary to fund a tentative budget for the 2003-2004 fiscal year; providing for severability; providing for repealer; providing an effective date
 - b. Resolution No.151-2003 (City Clerk reads *title.*)

A resolution of the City of Boca Raton adopting a tentative budget for the 2003 -2004 fiscal year; providing for severability; providing for repealer; providing an effective date
 - c. Discussion, public comments and explanation of “percentage increase in millage over the rolled-back rate necessary to fund the budget, if any, and the specific purposes for which ad valorem tax revenues are being increased.”
 - d. Open public hearing on tentative budget and tentative millage rates.
 - e. City Council “shall amend the tentative budget as it sees fit.”
 - f. Recomputation of tentative millage rates.

NOTICE

If any decision of City Council affects you, and you decide to appeal any decision made at this meeting with respect to any matter considered, you will need a record of the proceedings and, for such purposes, you may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. (The above NOTICE is required by State Law. Anyone desiring a verbatim transcript shall have the responsibility, at his own cost, to arrange for the transcript.)

- g. Public announcement of percent, if any, by which recomputed tentative millage rates exceed “rolled-back rate”, characterized as “percentage increase in property taxes tentatively adopted.”
 - h. Adopt Resolution No. 150-2003 incorporating recomputed tentative millage rates.
 - i. Adopt Resolution No. 151-2003 incorporating amended tentative budget.
 - j. Close public hearing.
2. Introduction of Ordinances:
- a. Ordinance No. 4732

An ordinance of the City of Boca Raton adopting final millage rates and levying ad valorem taxes for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2003 and ending September 30, 2004; stating the percentage by which the millage to be levied exceeds the “rolled-back rate”; directing the City Manager or the Office of Management and Budget Director to adjust the adopted millage rates in the event of changes in the assessment roll and taxable value; providing for severability; providing for repealer; providing an effective date
 - b. Ordinance No. 4733

An ordinance of the City of Boca Raton adopting a final budget and appropriating funds for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2003, and ending September 30, 2004; providing for severability; providing for repealer; providing an effective date
